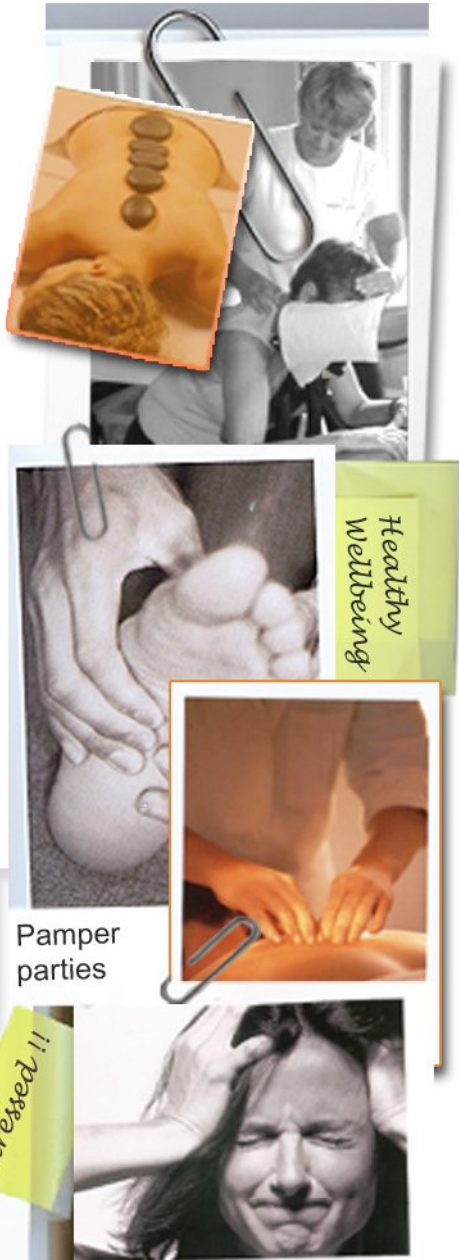

What is Botoxin?

Dynamic wrinkles are caused by contractions of the delicate underlying facial muscles every time you smile, laugh or frown. The more emotion you show, the deeper these wrinkles and lines are likely to be. While you may have earned every one of your worry lines, you don't have to show them anymore. Now, thanks to a new use for an approved drug, dynamic lines can be dramatically softened. The procedure known as cosmetic denervation uses Botoxin injections to improve the appearance of worry lines, frown lines, laugh lines, crow's feet and other dynamic wrinkles.

How it works

Botulinum toxin blocks the electrical activity across muscles, hence blocking muscular contraction. This is why following treatment, you look younger and those ugly wrinkles will disappear leaving you feeling more confident and have a greater inner satisfaction.

The toxin is injected using a very fine needle into several areas on the face. Only slight discomfort is felt during injection and the whole procedure takes between 5 and 15 minutes depending on what areas need treated.

Only tiny quantities of the toxin are injected and results are seen within 3 days and up to 14 days to see the full effect. Depending on the individual the effects last from 4-6 months but possibly longer following subsequent treatments.

Following treatment

For the first few hours do not rub your face, wash vigorously or be involved in vigorous exercise.

Try and avoid alcohol, hot curries or high temperatures.

By all means try and squint for an hour after treatment.

Do not lie down resting your face on a pillow or cushion for a few hours.

Possible side effects

Botoxin is very safe and any side effects will wear off within a few days. Rare adverse effects that can occur include; slight bruising at injection site, minor discomfort, slight swelling and rarely an allergic reaction. Occasional temporary drooping of the

eyelid may occur and take a few week to subside.
Contraindications include some drugs and antibiotics and vitamin E creams and aspirin which would need stopping 5 days before treatment.

Some neurological conditions may prevent treatment.
